



Important information for all uisitors to pride park stadium

Breach of Ground Regulations/Ticketing Terms & Conditions

All visitors to Pride Park Stadium must behave in accordance with the EFL's Ground Regulations and Derby County Football Club's conditions of issue of home/away tickets, Membership and Season Tickets (links directly below).

Reporting Incidents/Concern

We recognise that most supporters come to Pride Park Stadium to watch a football match without experiencing abusive or indecent language and gestures, and unruly behaviour from others.

Discrimination of any kind including shouting, chanting or actions such as racist, sectarian, homophobic, sexist, or anti-disability behaviour, is unacceptable.


If you experience or witness any of the above, please ask one of the matchday stewards to report the incident or your concerns, enabling us to act accordingly.

Matchdaų Text Service

On a matchday at Pride Park Stadium, you can report incidents or concerns directly to Derby County Match Control. Start your text with **DCFC**, then type your message and send to **88440**. Please include as much information as possible, including the stand, row, and seat details of where the incident or your concern occurred.







Complaints Policy

The club will seek to respond to all complaints within 10 working days of receipt. Thereafter complaints will, if appropriate, be subject to internal investigations.


Traffic Exclusion Zone/Resident Parking Zones


In the interest of pedestrian safety, a traffic exclusion zone is imposed around Pride Park Stadium on matchdays. It is in operation from 90 minutes prior to kick off and up to 60 minutes after the final whistle with precise timing dependent upon traffic and pedestrian movement on Derwent Parade and Royal Way.

Resident parking zones are in operation on matchdays with parking fines issued if contravened. The club advises supporters, where possible, to use official car parks.

Matchday First Aid Medical Provision

There are two St John Ambulance medical rooms located at Pride Park Stadium on matchdays. These are in the Northwest corner of the lower concourse and in the Southwest corner of the lower concourse. Matchday stewards are first aid trained and senior matchday stewards are trained in how to use a defibrillator which is located within the Security Office adjacent to the Toyota West Stand Main Entrance.

Medication

Flag Policy

Obviously, the club wants an exciting atmosphere at Pride Park Stadium and encourages all supporters to bring flags and banners, however these must adhere to our guidelines.

The club reserves the right to refuse flags or banners to be displayed, particularly if:

- defamatory or inflammatory
- as a weapon or compromises public safety
- provided in advance of matchday
- and **1000mm** in length
- covered at each end

• The content is considered offensive, discriminatory,


• Any part of the flag or banner could potentially be used

• Any item above the area of **600mm x1000mm** must be flame retardant and carry a fire safety certificate

• The flagpole should be no bigger than **7mm** in diameter

STAYING OVER?

If you are staying over in Derby for the night, you may wish to make a booking with one of our local hotels. We have outlined a description, the distance from the stadium and relevant contact details for each of the hotels.



Bų Rail

East Midlands Railway operates high-speed trains to and from London and regional train services across the East Midlands and South Yorkshire. You can also book all UK train tickets through the East Midlands Railway website ensuring your arrival at Pride Park Stadium is quick and comfortable. Derby Train Station is the closest train station to Pride Park Stadium and is approximately a 14-minute walk (0.8 miles) and the shortest route on foot is as follows:

- Walk east on Roundhouse Road
- Turn right to stay on Roundhouse Road
- At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Pride Park Way/A6
- At the Roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Derwent Parade
- At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Royal Way
- You have reached Pride Park Stadium

YOUR MATCH TICKETS

Your match tickets provide vital information, which will help you find your way on matchday. Please see the annotated diagram on the following page, which explains what the various parts of the match ticket mean. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact the Ticket Office via email on **ticket.office@dcfc.co.uk**

If you require ticketing assistance in advance of the day of the game, please contact your own club's Ticket Office for advice.

If you have any ticketing queries on the day of the game prior to entering the stadium, away supporters are advised to visit the Away Ticket Office located next to the away turnstiles, which is on the southeast corner of the ground.

Any other ticketing queries, such as directions to your turnstile or your seat and queries regarding stadium regulations/terms and conditions should be directed towards our stewarding team who will be on hand outside Pride Park Stadium.

Duplicate Ticket Requests/Collections

Duplicate ticket requests will only be fulfilled if the information is sent to us, via email, from the visiting club's Ticket Office. If a supporter misplaces their ticket, they must contact their own club who will authorise and inform Derby County. Duplicate tickets will not be issued without the authorisation of the visiting club. If duplicate tickets are arranged, they will be available to collect from our Away Ticket Office, located at the Southeast corner of the stadium, from 1 hour and 30 minutes, prior to kickoff on the day of the game and only on the production of valid photo ID.



When you arrive to your specific turnstile, please insert the barcode into the mouth of the reader. The light on the turnstile should flash green and you should be able to walk through the turnstile. Should the light flash red please see the nearest steward.

DISABLED SUPPORTER INFORMATION

At Derby County we take our responsibilities towards disabled supporters very seriously. We recognise that disabled supporters may need assistance to fully enjoy the matchday experience and offer a variety of reasonable adjustments. Please note, all reasonable adjustments are subject to qualification and availability. Please contact your club's Ticket Office to ensure that the appropriate reasonable adjustments are allocated to you.

Personal Assistant Tickets

We offer complimentary PA/Essential Companion tickets to supporters that need support from another person to be able to enjoy the matchday experience to the same standard as all supporters (subject to qualification), Please contact your own club's Ticket Office for further information.

Wheelchair Spaces

Wheelchair users are accommodated on the Southeast Corner Elevated Wheelchair Platform, or the front row of the Southeast Corner Lower tier (AA row).

Wheelchair space locations are subject to change based on Pride Park Stadium seating configuration for certain matches.

Easy Access Seating

Disabled supporters that require easy access seating must stipulate their seating requirements at the time of purchase to ensure appropriate seating is provided (subject to availability). It is recommended for those disabled supporters requiring easy access seating to purchase tickets on either AA, BB, or CC rows, as these rows have minimal steps (no more than 3 steps up).

Seating locations are subject to change based on Pride Park Stadium seating configuration for certain matches.

Accessible Entrances

We have accessible entrances available on a matchday for away disabled supporters and it is recommended that you use Gate S; this entrance is located at the South-east corner of the stadium (please see map on page 16)


Audio Descriptive Commentary

Please contact the Disability Team on **01332 667528** to reserve a headset/receiver no later than 24 hours prior to the fixture date (subject to availability).





Accessible Toilets

Accessible toilets can be found in each stand concourse area, and these are clearly signposted. Should you require assistance, please seek advice from the nearest steward. All accessible toilets operate using a 'radar' key system. We would advise you to bring your 'radar' access key with you.

Catering Facilities

We have catering facilities located within the away concourse area of the stadium, however, these serving counters located in this area are high level counters. The club makes reasonable adjustments to enable disabled spectators to access the catering facilities by instructing one of our dedicated stewards to monitor the areas in which wheelchair users are located to ascertain whether any additional help is required.

We offer a range and food and drinks in each concourse.

Accessible Car Parking

The club has a dedicated car parking area at Pride Park Stadium for away disabled supporters (Blue Badge Holders only) - at a cost of £10 and this area of parking is located within 100 yards of the away seating area in the Southeast Corner. Spaces are allocated on a first come first served basis and please be aware that you will be asked to show and display your Blue Badge. These must be booked no later than 24 hours prior to the match. Please contact the Derby County Ticket Office, on 01332 667528 to book your space (subject to availability).



Shuttle Service

The club operates a free shuttle service using buggies to transfer disabled supporters who require extra help from our car parks. This service runs up to kick-off and resumes after the final whistle, although supporters should note that due to congestion, the shuttle service may suspend operation for a brief period for the safety of all our supporters.



GENERAL MATCHDAY INFORMATION

Need Help or Assistance

If you need assistance in finding your way around Pride Park Stadium there are a few outlets of information available to you.

Firstly, our stewarding team are strategically located in their high visibility uniforms to give assistance with any questions which you may have, they have a high knowledge of local amenities and stadium access; if they do not know a piece of information, they will endeavour to find someone that does. Our designated Matchday Supporter Liaison Officers will also be on hand to deal with any of your queries too; look for their blue 'Fans First' jacket!


Away Supporter Parking

Parking for away supporters is provided at the Derby Conference Centre on London Road (A6), which is located at DE24 8UX about a 10–15-minute walk from Pride Park Stadium. There is space for 200 vehicles, and the charge is £8 per car. As you come into Derby you can follow the road signs for Away Supporter parking which will guide you towards the Conference Centre



Away Turnstile Location

Our away turnstiles are located at the South-east corner of the stadium (see map below) and will open from 1 hour and 30 minutes prior to kick-off.





DCFC MEGASTORE

The DCFCMegastore is open seven days a week at Pride Park Stadium; Monday to Saturday from 9am – 5pm and Sunday 10am-4pm with Bank Holidays operating on Sunday hours.

The retail operation also offers online orders at dcfcmegastore.com. The online service is separate from the store. Currently there is no click and collect option available into store. All orders that require an exchange or refund must be sent back to the online store. Click the Help tab under Customer Service on the DCFCMegastore website for instructions on how to do this.

Returns Policy

In addition to your statutory rights, items can be returned or exchanged within 30 days of purchase for a full refund or exchange of equivalent value, provided the item is still in its original condition and accompanied by an itemised receipt.

Personalised items are exempt from our returns policy and cannot be exchanged or refunded. Your statutory rights are not affected by our returns policy.

Please note that items purchased online cannot be returned to store. Please visit dcfcmegastore.co.uk for more information.

For refunds, please allow 5-10 working days for the amount to appear in your bank account. This time frame is dictated by your bank or card issuer and is outside of our control. Your refund will be credited to the same card with which you made your original purchase.


